Position:	The Custodial Services Associate is responsible for maintaining a clean, safe, and welcoming campus environment that supports the University's academic programs, residential life, and faith-based mission. This position requires reliability, attention to detail, and a service-oriented approach in support of students, faculty, staff, and campus visitors.
Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Perform routine custodial duties, including vacuuming, sweeping, mopping, dusting, and sanitizing assigned areas. • Clean and disinfect restrooms, breakrooms, classrooms, offices, residence halls, and common areas in accordance with established sanitation standards. • Empty trash and recycling receptacles and dispose of waste following University procedures. • Sweep and mop floors using proper safety practices to prevent slip and fall hazards. • Monitor cleaning supply inventory for assigned buildings and notify the supervisor when restocking is required. • Identify and promptly report unsafe conditions, damaged fixtures, or maintenance concerns to the supervisor. • Assist with deep cleaning, disinfecting, and special projects as assigned. • Provide custodial support for campus events, including setup and post-event cleanup, as directed. • Perform all duties in a manner that reflects respect for the University's Christian values and community standards.

Primary Requirement:	Must have strongly expressed a commitment to Jesus Christ, the teachings and mission of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, be a member of the Seventh-day Adventist church in good and regular standing, and have a desire to serve in a cooperative, spiritually redemptive, and soul-winning atmosphere.
