

EMERGENCY PROTOCOLS FOR MISSION TRIP PARTICIPANTS
NAVAJO MISSION TRIP 2026

Your safety is our top priority. Please review and follow these protocols in the event of an emergency:

1. Stay Calm and Follow Instructions

- Remain calm and listen carefully to the instructions of the mission team leader.

2. Contact a Mission Team Leader Immediately

- If you are in danger, injured, or separated from the group, contact your designated team leader as soon as possible. Participants will be emailed a list of mission team leader contacts prior to the trip.

3. Emergency Contact Information

- You will be sent by email a list of mission team leader contacts prior to the trip.

4. Medical Emergencies

- Inform a team leader right away.
- Carry your medical insurance card and a list of any allergies or medications.

5. Natural Disasters or Civil Unrest

- Follow the instructions of local authorities and your team leader.
- Move to the designated safe area or shelter if instructed.
- Stay with your group unless directed otherwise.

6. Lost or Missing Person

- Notify your team leader immediately.
- Do not attempt to search alone.

7. Communication Plan

- Use the designated group messaging app set up prior to the trip.

8. Trip Interruption and Emergency Return Procedures

- In the event of a severe emergency, participants will be promptly transported home under the direction of team leaders. Full cooperation with all instructions and procedures is required to ensure the safety and well-being of the entire group.

9. Documentation

- Keep a copy of your passport (non-US citizens), ID, and emergency contacts in a secure place.
- Report any lost documents to your team leader and local authorities.
